What To Expect From Your Telehealth Genetic Counseling Session

It is recommended that you find a quiet space to limit interruptions during your appointment.



30 minutes is reserved for your telehealth visit



The genetic counselor will collect your relevant personal and family medical history



Based on the information you provide, you will know during your appointment whether you are a candidate for genetic testing



Receive information related to the testing process, screening and any preventative recommendations



Ability to ask any questions you may have



If genetic testing is pursued, results information will be sent to both you and HNF

If you or a family member have had genetic testing, we encourage you to obtain a copy of your test result (or your family member's test result) and submit through our patient portal prior to your session. It may also be helpful to talk to other family members to better understand any health conditions in the family, as well as the age that your relatives were diagnosed.

Genetic Counseling Costs

Insurance Billing

Genetic counseling may be covered by your health insurance plan*. InformedDNA® will obtain your insurance information to verify active coverage and in-network status. InformedDNA® bills in-network insurance and collects any copay or deductible due directly from you. The exact cost for services rendered will depend on your insurance coverage. For in-network health insurance, it is typically between \$30-50.

Self-Pay

InformedDNA® offers a self-pay option if you have an out-of-network insurance, or no insurance. The charge for your initial genetic counseling appointment is \$175, and the follow up appointment is \$75.

Genetic Testing Costs

If genetic testing is pursued, charges for genetic testing are separate. Your genetic counselor or the testing laboratory will communicate with you if there are any expected out-of-pocket costs for the testing. The self pay rate for testing is \$500 at the lab.
